Purpose of camp:	CTE Middle School Boot Camp is an immersive and unique CTE Program that will engage students in one of 6 different content strands intentionally designed for their connection to existing and planned NPT Region III CTE programs and in response to the strength and projected growth in higher-wage, higher-demand jobs in our State and Region. Current CTE teachers will operate our camps to highlight the career pathways students can enter at the high school level.

Field Trips:	Most programs will include one or more field trips to industry locations.

Emergency Medical Technician (EMT): Students will be introduced to Junior CPR/First Aid and practice splinting, bleeding control and shock management. They will also learn how to respond to asthma attacks, anaphylaxis, cardiac arrest and heat and cold emergencies. Students will use CPR manikins and learn proper use of Automated Emergency Defibrillator (AED) and pocket mask. Demonstration of the SIM MAN ALS will be provided as well as an ambulance introduction. Students must wear long pants and sneakers as a safety precaution. A Junior CPR/First Aid certificate is possible for those who successfully complete the EMT summer camp program. A visit from area fire departments will take place on the third day.

Construction Technology & Cabinetmaking: Where would any of us be without builders and furniture makers? Students will learn how to safely use various woodworking equipment especially our new commercial CNC (Computer Numeric Control) tool. Students will learn the principles of sign engraving, strengths of adhesives with hardwoods, and wood joinery. We will make glue-ups with various wood and adhesives then students will perform a strength test and complete a failure analysis. Students will also be challenged with various project design activities such as making a personal sign or cutting board using the CNC imagery software. Students must wear long pants and leather shoes or boots for safety precaution.

Welding Technology: Students will be taught the basics of Gas Metal Arc Welding along with safety rules and principles. Those who can withstand the sparks, fire, and heat will successfully complete two different hands-on projects, including use of the CNC (Computer Numeric Control) plasma table where students will manufacture a project that will be brought home at the end of the day. Students must wear long pants and leather shoes or boots for safety precautions. There will be competitions throughout the days and prizes will be awarded. A visit to a relevant business will take place on the third day.

Web Design/Digital Communication: Digital communication is a part of any profession you choose. Students that sign up for this class will learn about photography and how to enhance and manipulate their photos using Adobe Photoshop. Students will also learn how to use edit video, graphics, and use the green screen effect in iMovie. Students will learn the basics of Javascript coding to make characters move on command. Lastly, a reporter from WABI-TV will visit to show the students how to put a news story together. They will also leave with a poster that they created and a certificate of the standards they completed from Adobe. Students will learn and have fun doing it during this 3 day workshop.

Culinary Arts: Grab a chef's hat and let us whisk you away into an exciting world of new foods and flavors. From fresh breads to pastries to homemade pasta and more, students will work as part of a team to create delicious foods. Students will have the opportunity to work with current culinary arts students to practice cake decorating with gum paste, fondant, buttercream and more. On the last day of camp students will cook and enjoy a delicious meal that they have designed, planned and created themselves. A field trip to a local restaurant will give the students a fun "behind the scenes" look at the culinary industry. This class is fun and jam packed with activities. Please wear close toed shoes and bring a great attitude. See you in April!

Law Enforcement (Public Safety Careers) Program: Students will be introduced to the individual equipment that every Police Officer uses while on patrol duty. They will be provided instruction, and demonstration, on all equipment items by the Law Enforcement Instructor. They will also get an opportunity for "hands-on" practical application skills training with the PR-24 and ASP Defensive Batons, Handcuffs, Flashlight, Search Mirrors, Fingerprinting, Blue Training Guns (Pistol, Rifle, and Shotgun), and Unmanned Aerial Systems (Drone) Technology. A NRA Firearm Safety Course will also be taught. The students will then undergo Traffic Stop Training and will have the opportunity to be both the Suspect and the Police Officer at various times during the training scenarios which will utilize a Real Police Cruiser and Radio. A Field Trip to the Town of Lincoln Police Station will take place on the third day.
