My activities in the past month included:

- Diana St. Pierre with WCCC visited Region 3 on 11/28 and 11/29; several students were interested. Tim Peters and I talked with Diana about possible concurrent credit agreements for Law Enforcement, CDL, and our other programs. Theresa Smith, KVCC Admissions Director, visited our students on 12/6/17; we have students applying to their Lineman and Culinary programs. We also briefly discussed concurrent agreements.

- I attended a Bridge Year program meeting at Schenck HS on 12/12; I spoke with all of the Bridge students and met with three prospective 2018 Bridge families.
